Good evening Grace,

You asked me not to contact you outside of "business hours" which includes the weekend. Therefore I did not phone you back. I apologise for disturbing you at home, I

had no idea the phone number given on the website was for a residence, and had expected to leave a message.

For the present, I simply wish to alert you to the fact that in my view your registration of the name "AWINZ" and your website are illegal. As already advised, your registration was clearly carried out in contravention of section 15 of the Charitable Trusts Act and was designed to mislead and confuse the public and undermine the work of the existing charity. For the same reasons your website will require to be closed down.

I would strongly advise you to take legal advice this week on these issues, particularly your actions in seeking public donations over your website for your organisation in circumstances where the name used is clearly designed to create confusion. Your lawyer may also be able to suggest alternative ways for you to raise your clearly heartfelt concerns within the law.

I have now been advised that AWINZ has already received a written legal opinion from a leading law firm canvassing its options in respect of your actions. It will be instructing solicitors to follow up this week and you will I'm sure receive written notice of the firm acting in due course, and have an opportunity to discuss matters with the lawyer involved.

Due to the urgency of the situation I am helping in the meantime in a voluntary capacity and have "gotten the ball rolling" with the Ministry to see your organisation removed from the register as quickly as possible. I have no wish to discuss this with you in person over the weekend.

I also note that I no longer require your advice as to your ISP as I have that information now. I will be passing it on to the appropriate authorities on Tuesday.

I wish you good luck in pursuing your concerns for pet owners' interests in a more appropriate manner. As a cat owner I can empathise over the very sad circumstances in which Chloe was euthanased without her owners having had an opportunity to say goodbye.

I believe in facts and proof and until I received such from you I will consider any action from you as harassment .

In our country the first step of any dispute is discussion you cannot make allegations and keep me in the dark

If you are legally in a position to represent any party I will be very happy to speak to you and discuss your perceived problems.

If you are not , kindly stay out of something that does not concern you .

Dear Grace,

1. I have given you the provision you need. I again suggest you read it and discuss it with your lawyer. Information on internet ethics can be obtained from your ISP on Great Barrier.
2. I am not the decision maker here, and I have no obligation to supply you with "proof". In fact I only advised you of my concerns to give you an opportunity to rectify the situation yourself before the authorities step in. It would obviously be in your own interests to do so.
