

I apologise for the delay – I have been overseas.

I confirm that the Animal Welfare Institute of New Zealand is an approved organisation under the Animal Welfare Act 1999 under which North Shore Animal Care and Control operates.

In respect of ~~*****~~ confirm that on the payment of \$407.75 as set out in your letter of 4 August 2005, the prosecution will be withdrawn on the basis of diversion.

The payment should be made to the Animal Welfare Institute of New Zealand at P O Box 60-208, Titirangi. Alternatively you may have a cheque with you just prior to the hearing set down for Tuesday 13th September 2005.
