I sincerely apologize for any trouble I have caused you or Transparency New Zealand.

I barely remember doing it and to be honest I was not acting in character at the time.

The fact is that I have a chronic disease. Periodically throughout the year I have been on very strong steroids in an attempt to treat some of the very unpleasant symptoms of my disease. One of the unfortunate side effects of the medication is uninhibited behaviour and strong emotion, including sometimes anger. Sometimes that anger has been directed at things legitimate to be angry about. Sometimes I have just hit out with it. That was only by making a dumb comment or two online, but I know that can cause damage itself.

The fact that I did this to you, to a website concerned with transparency - run by a private investigator! - just goes to show how my thinking process was affected by the medication. I made a couple of mistakes this year as a result and I am trying to remedy that now.

If there is anything else I can do above apologizing, let me know. I could probably give you a call to explain myself but to be honest I really would like to avoid any more embarrassment and such. I could even probably provide you with medical evidence if you really want but I'd rather not have to.

I would like to request that the letter online containing my (old) flat's email address be taken down from the web in light of the condition I was in when the post was made, and in light of the fact that the people at the flat could potentially be needlessly affected by my actions.
