**FILE 4192: Complaint by Grace Haden**

As confirmed to you by Kristin Percy, the extension of time for you to reply to Grace Haden's complaint is 10 June 2011.

I have been in contact with Malcolm Ellis with respect to your concerns about the complaint being handled in Auckland as opposed to our Wellington office. The usual practice is that all complaints are dealt with on the papers and there are no oral submissions given by either party (complainant or lawyer complained about) unless the Standards Committee deem it necessary for the purpose of clarification of issues or facts which are already before them. This would be in the context of a hearing on the papers and this matter has not proceeded to that stage yet. Generally speaking it is only credibility issue(s) or facts which are disputed which causes this form of inquiry, in that the Committee requires the parties to be heard in person.

I have asked Grace Haden to send a copy of the annexure you have pointed out is missing and I will forward it to you when I receive it.

From perusing the file it appears these are the following issues for you to address:

- I. Whether or not you gave legal advice to two barristers namely Hoadley and Wells in Court proceedings CIV 2006 – 004 – 001784 and CIV 2008 – 404 – 5500 that you were not able to give, either because you were working without a practicing certificate and/or there was a conflict of interest situation;
- II. That there are emails showing that you had intimidated Ms Haden and additionally, on 2 June 2006 in a late night phone call you apparently intimidated her; *- thoughtless but wasn't legal work. was just going to leave message but got her instead.*
- III. That you prepared a statement of claim working pro bono for Mr Wells without a practicing certificate. Mr Neutze filed this statement of claim but Ms Haden states that you prepared it; *- background research on internet defamation - Law clerk - qualified lawyer.*
- IV. You may also wish to explain whether or not there is a conflict of interest or otherwise in relation to the complaint regarding your former husband Mr

Wright. On this point I refer you to Ms Haden's initial letter of complaint where she states:

*"The evidence which has been presented with this is Mr Wright's (her former husband) statement to the Law Society which stated:*

*After some months, as Mr Wells realized that Mrs Haden's campaign was not going to abate with time, he, together with the other trustees of AWINZ at the time, sought legal counsel. Initial contact was made by Mr Wells to Ms Vivian Parre (who was at the time married to Mr Wright). Ms Parre was employed at Brookfields at the time, and the instruction turned to Brookfields"*


*Enquiries have revealed that Vivian was not employed at Brookfields at the time nor did she have a practicing certificate which enabled her to provide legal advice.*

*Statements of Mr Wells and Mrs Hoadley show that they calling themselves trustees of AWINZ sought legal counsel. Mr Wright confirms that the initial contact was with his then wife Vivian.*

*I have attached annexure 1 which it he account which Mr Wright gives of the events and my clarification which identified the role that I make the complaint that she acted as legal counsel while not having a practicing certificate and about the manner an intimidation nature of her actions which led to five years abuse of the Courts and misrepresentation to the Court."*
